Starting from Meldreth Station, this circular walk takes you past all 19 Thatched Cottages in Meldreth

DIRECTIONS

- (D) From Meldreth Station take the path which crosses the field towards Melbourn. Where the path joins Station Road, turn right and visit 61 Orchard Cottage and 63.
- (1) Continue along Station Road, walking under the road bridge and visit 9 Fieldgate Cottage and 3 Meldreth Thatch. Cross over the railway bridge and bear left into Whitecroft Road to visit 9 Walnut Cottage, 27, 30 and 32.
- (2) Turn left into Chiswick End and visit 23 and 34 Fordham's Cottage before retracing your steps back to Whitecroft Road.
- (3) Turn left and visit 41 Bluebell
 Cottage before retracing your steps
 down Whitecroft Road.
- (4) At Elin Way turn left and follow the road all the way to the High Street.

- (5) Turn left and visit 70 Keys Cottage and 51 The Old Bell. At this point you can visit the British Queen a quaint traditional freehouse with homemade, locally sourced food, or continue on to Applecote 85 High Street.
- (6) Continue onto North End and visit 9-11 Willow Way Cottage, 13
 Homeland, 19 The Cottage and 29
 The Old Town House, then carry on to Holy Trinity Church.
- (7) Here you can either carry on to number 98 then return, or turn right on the footpath to Topcliffe Mill.
- (8) Follow the path round the left side of the Mill and across the field into Melwood local nature reserve.
- (9) When you reach the junction with Flambards Close, cross the river and return to the High Street.
- (10) Turn left at the High Street and this will bring you back to Meldreth Station.
